



STANDARDISED PRICE LIST

All funeral directors are legally required to publish this Price List for a standardised set of products and services. This is to help you think through your options and make choices and to let you compare prices between different funeral directors (because prices can vary)

ATTENDED CREMATION FUNERAL (funeral director's charges only)	£2,765.00
This is a funeral where family and friends have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person at the same time as they attend their burial or cremation.	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Taking care of all necessary legal and administrative arrangements 	£1,650.00
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Collection and conveyance of the deceased from the place of death to within our care (normally within 35 miles of our premises at 35 The Square, Grantown-on-Spey, PH26 3HF) 	£180.00
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Care of the deceased person before the funeral within appropriate facilities. The deceased person will be cared for at our premises in Grantown-on-Spey. First and Last offices will be administered by our in-house state registered Nurse. 	£250.00
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Providing a suitable coffin – this will be made from Oak/Light Oak veneered coffin upholstered with fine quality white satin interior linings and pillows, furnished with carrying handles and engraved nameplate. 	£445.00
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Viewing of the deceased person for family and friends by appointment with the funeral director (where viewing is requested by the customer out-of-hours regardless of time there is no fee to view the deceased) 	£0.01
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At a date and time you agree with the funeral director, conveying the deceased person from within our care direct to the agreed cemetery or crematorium (normally within 35 miles of the funeral director's premises) in a hearse or other appropriate vehicle. 	£240.00

UNATTENDED FUNERAL	
This is a funeral where family and friends may choose to have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person, but they do not attend the burial or cremation itself.	
Burial (funeral director's charges only)	£1,250.00
Cremation (funeral director's charges plus the cremation fee) ²	£1,749.00

FEE'S YOU MUST PAY	
For an Attended or Unattended burial funeral, the burial fee . ¹	
In this local area, the typical cost of the burial fee for residents is:	£959.00
For a new grave, you will also need to pay for the plot; for an existing grave with a memorial in place, you may need to pay a removal/replacement fee. In addition, the cemetery may charge several other fees.	As charged

¹ This fee (which is sometimes called the interment fee) is the charge made for digging and closing a new grave or for reopening and closing an existing grave.

² In England, Wales and Northern Ireland, you will usually need to pay doctors' fees as well. This is the charge for two doctors to sign the Medical Certificates for Cremation.
